Declaration of the quality of Official Statistics

The National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic (hereinafter referred to as the National Statistical Committee), as the leading producer of official statistics responsible for coordinating the development, production, and dissemination of official statistics in the national statistical system, undertakes the commitment to ensure the quality of disseminated data and adherence to the key parameters of official statistics, such as relevance, accuracy, reliability, timeliness, punctuality, transparency, clarity, comparability, and compatibility.

In its activities, the National Statistical Committee is guided by internationally recognized principles of quality management, including user orientation, leadership, the approach to quality management as an interactive process between producers and users, a commitment to continuous improvement, decisionmaking based on objective information, and managing relationships with all stakeholders.

In accordance with the Law of the Kyrgyz Republic "On Official Statistics," the National Statistical Committee:

- Coordinates the activities of the national statistical system;
- Adopts modern international statistical standards and best practices;
- Upholds professional independence;

• Ensures impartiality, objectivity, and transparency in its activities, comprehensively studying and identifying new user needs;

- Timely provides users with statistical information;
- Enhances data sources;
- Upholds statistical confidentiality and data security.

The National Statistical Committee effectively utilizes available resources and takes measures to mobilize necessary additional resources for data production that aligns with users' information requirements. At the same time, it does this in such a way that the production of statistics does not lead to an unjustified additional burden on respondents during data collection. The National Statistical Committee makes every effort to carry out its work to the best of its ability, systematically identifying its strengths and weaknesses, along with associated risks, during the monitoring of quality assurance measures. The National Statistical Committee consistently provides information about statistical processes and products to users in the form of quality reports on its website.
