1. GEOGRAPHICAL CHARACTERISTICS, CLIMATE AND ENVIRONMENT

The Kyrgyz Republic is located in the north-east of the Central Asia. The country is bounded on the north by Kazakhstan, the south-west by Uzbekistan, the south by Tajikistan, on the east and south-east by China. The total length of boundaries of Kyrgyzstan is 4,5 thsd. km, and its territory is 199,9 thsd. km<sup>2</sup>.

Kyrgyzstan is a mountainous country. Almost 90% of the total territory is located higher than 1 500 meters above sea level.

As of January 1, 2023, the number of resident population of the country has made up 7,0 million people. The average population density is 35 people per square kilometer.

The capital city of the country is Bishkek with a population 1,1 million people.

Big cities: Osh (361,3 thousand people), Djalal-Abad (129,4 thousand people), Karakol (82,0 thousand people), Tokmok (74,3 thousand people), Uzgen (62,5 thousand people).

The largest oblast in the area is Naryn (45,2 thousand sq. km).

The most densely populated oblasts are Chui (53 people per 1 sq. km) and Osh (50 people per 1 sq. km).

Currently, the system of administrative and territorial structure of the republic includes 7 oblasts (regions) and 2 cities of republican level, 40 administrative districts, 32 cities, 9 urban-type settlements, 3 villages and 452 aiyl aimaks (village community).

There are more than 3,500 thousand rivers and rivulets and 1 923 lakes in the republic. There are 44 deposits of underground fresh and mineral waters.

The climate of the country is sharply continental, summer in the cities is rather hot, and relatively cool in the mountains. Winters are cold and snowy, especially in the highlands. The average air temperature in summer in Kyrgyzstan is  $+27^{\circ}$ C, the average minimum temperature is  $+16^{\circ}$ C and the average maximum temperature is kept at  $+33^{\circ}$ C. In winter, air temperature is on average  $+1^{\circ}$ C, the average minimum temperature is  $-12^{\circ}$ C, and the average maximum temperature is kept at  $+10^{\circ}$ C.

#### 2. PUBLIC AUTHORITIES AND MANAGEMENT, MAIN SOCIO-ECONOMIC INDICATORS

The Kyrgyz Republic (Kyrgyzstan) is an independent, sovereign, democratic, unitary, secular and social State governed by the rule of law. State authority is based on the principle of the separation of legislative, executive and judicial power.

The President is the Head of the State and executive power and the highest official. The President is elected by the citizens of the Kyrgyz Republic for a term of five years.

The Jogorku Kenesh - the Parliament of the Kyrgyz Republic - is the highest representative body exercising legislative power and oversight functions within the limits of its competence

Executive power in the Kyrgyz Republic is exercised by the President.

The structure and composition of the Cabinet of Ministers is set out by the President.

The Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers is the head of the Presidential Administration.

The judicial system of the Kyrgyz Republic is established by the Constitution and laws, and consists of the Constitutional Court, the Supreme Court, and local courts.





Marriages and divorces (thousand)












### Employed population by type of economic activity in 2021<sup>1</sup>

# **State budget expenditures for social protection** (at the end of the year, as a percentage of the previous year)









### 9. TOURISM

In 2022, 441 recreation facilities and tourism organizations accepted and served tourists, of which 182 specialized accommodation facilities, 212 hotels and similar accommodation facilities, 11 natural parks and reserves, 36 other tourist facilities, 60 travel agencies and tour operators, excursion bureaus as well. In addition, 1 259 guest houses accepted and served tourists.

In 2022 the number of persons who rested made up about 2 million people, of which more than 62 percent were in the Issyk-Kul region.

In 2022 7,8 thousand citizens of Kyrgyzstan and 6,6 thousand people traveling around Kyrgyzstan were moved to other countries through travel companies, of which 2,9 thousand people were citizens of other countries.

According to data of the State Border Service, the number of foreign citizens crossing the border of the Kyrgyz Republic by country of citizenship (arrivals) in 2022 exceeded 7 million people and increased by 2 times compared to 2021.




#### Consumer price index



(as percentage)




## **Structure of industrial products in 2022** (as a percentage to the total)




#### Foreign direct investment structure






